What do managers of participation do?

The management of participation is supposed to show young refugees between 18 and 27 paths into apprenticeship, qualification and employment.

The managers of participation consult and support tolerated and allowed refugees regardless of their prospective of residence.

They assist in the search for internships, apprenticeships and jobs.

They offer support in housing, finances, health and leisure time.

They show funding opportunities for young refugees who have not had access to the regular offerings so far.

Our target group are refugees

- aged from 18 to 27, primarily with Duldung
- secondarily with residence permit
- who do not have to attend school anymore
- who need help with in the areas of education and career

Our tasks

- individual consultation and support
- recognizing potentials
- assessment and analysis of needs
- developing perspectives of professional and social participation
- assessment and documentation of all measures at site
- networking and social environment work
- outreach work
